USING THE REST-STYLE COMMUNICATION FOR MOBILE CLIENTS

There can be some connectivity problems when trying to use a mobile device as a client. The Socket connections can time out very easily and so a REST-style of invocation might be preferred. The system provides all of the classes for this, where the following code has been tested on Android only; but does work. To invoke a licas service from an Android mobile phone, you could use the following procedure:
